Basic Tour, 45 minutes Suggested program fee: \$75 for up to 15 participants. * Complete tour of the farm including the fields, greenhouse, beehives and solar house. Discussion of our mission, programs, sustainable farming practices and environmental stewardship. Appropriate for all ages.

Sensory Exploration, 1 hour Suggested program fee: \$75 for up to 15 participants. *

Tour of the farm including the fields, greenhouse, beehives and solar house. Follow your senses through the field, tasting, smelling and observing along the way. Search for insects and pollinators. See up close what it takes to grow healthy and sustainable food. Take a trip to our Discovery Garden to seed, water or harvest.

Seed to Harvest Educational Tour, 1.5 - 2 Hours Suggested program fee: \$125 for up to 15 participants. * Complete tour of farm including the fields, greenhouse, beehives and solar house. Discussion of our mission, programs, sustainable farming practices and environmental stewardship. Opportunities to taste, smell and observe along the way. Cooking activity with produce from the fields. Appropriate for all ages.

Service Visit, 2-5 hours Suggested program fee: \$50 for 9/10am-12pm, \$75 for 9/10am-2pm (with break for *lunch*) Brief introduction to the farm followed by 2+ hours of service in our fields or greenhouse. Activities include harvesting, planting, weeding, general field maintenance. Appropriate for ages 12+, max group size is 12 participants.

* As a non-profit, the suggested program fee is an important part of how we cover administrative and staffing needs for your visit. However, no group will be turned away due to lack of funds. Those who pay the full suggested fee, or more, help to subsidize those groups that are unable to pay the entire amount.
